Burial Chamber Regulations

Exclusive Right Of Burial

- 1 The burial chamber space in which exclusive right of burial has been granted shall be kept and used solely as a burial place for two deceased persons and no other use shall be made.*
- 2 The deceased must be interred in hermetically sealed coffins.*
- 3 The party in whose favour the right of burial has been granted ["the Proprietor"] (and his/her heirs or successors) may not gratuitously dispose of or sell this right. However, the Proprietor may assign the right in his/her will.*
- 4 In cases where there is no will, the right of burial shall pass to the eldest child. Where there are no children, the eldest representative according to the rules of heritable succession of the Law of Scotland shall succeed.*
- 5 No heir (or successor) of the Proprietor shall have any right or interest in the burial chamber space until he/she has provided satisfactory evidence to the Company.*
- 6 The exclusive right of burial will be granted in perpetuity or until the Cemetery is no longer used as a burial ground.*
- 7 The Proprietor (and his/her heirs and successors) will only be entitled to exercise the right of burial in the burial chamber space upon payment of the interment fees which will be fixed from time to time by the Company.*

Erection of Memorials

- 8 No enclosing walls, fence or building shall be erected in the vicinity of the burial chamber in which the exclusive right of burial of has been granted.*
- 9 No memorial plaque other than that supplied by the Company shall be fixed to the burial chamber.*
- 10 It will be the responsibility of the Company to maintain any memorial plaque fixed to the burial chamber.*
- 11 Fresh cut flowers may be placed in the holders provided.*
- 12 Memorials may only be placed on the lid with the permission of the Superintendent, and must maintain the dignity and reverence of the burial chambers and surrounding area.*

Works within the Cemetery

- 13 No works of any kind will be permitted in the cemetery, unless authorised by the Company. The Superintendent will determine when any works can be carried out. All workmen will be responsible to the Superintendent, who may ask them to leave if they cause any offence.*
- 14 Materials used shall be of the best quality and works must be completed with the minimum of delay. All refuse remaining after works have been completed must be removed immediately.*

General

- 15 Visitors to the Cemetery are expected to be appropriately dressed and to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times, and must not be allowed to intimidate other visitors, or the local wildlife. The Superintendent has the right to refuse admission to the Cemetery.*
- 16 The Proprietor (and his/her heirs or successors) will be bound by such rules and regulations as the Company may from time to time impose.*
