

As it becomes increasingly common for clients to personalise services at the Crematorium, especially in respect of the music that is played, we have decided to invest in the Wesley Music On-Line Crematorium Music System in order to offer a greater choice to the bereaved.

This computer-based system currently stores hundreds of the most popular tracks played at funerals, and resolves all royalty and copyright issues for music played on the system.

The music is arranged alphabetically on the system in three libraries as follows:

**Hymns:** Listed by first line. Many Hymns include a small choir, and an organ only version is also available if preferred. All entries contain details of tunes, verses, and words.

**Entry/Exit:** Organ music of many popular works.

**General:** Everything else! i.e.; anything that is not a hymn or an organ piece.

For music that is not already on our system it will be possible for us to order this directly from Wesley Music. They will search for the music required (or record it in the case of a hymn, albeit without choir in such instances) and, providing it is currently commercially available, transfer (download) the requested tracks onto our computer here at the Crematorium prior to the service it is required for\*. Music can then be selected from the relevant library ahead of the service and played during a funeral at the touch of a button. Once a track has been requested, downloaded and played it is retained on the computer for future use.

This list is updated weekly.

To order music please use our revised Music Request Form

You will need to give us at least TWO WORKING DAYS notice in most cases (more is better wherever possible, please) in order for Wesley Music to locate and prepare the track, and for the subsequent download to take place.

We anticipate that this new system will eradicate the need to bring in CDs and tapes belonging to the family and will make arranging music for funerals much easier for all concerned, but most of all we want to make arranging music for funerals as trouble free as possible.

Should the client have a particular CD, tape or old vinyl record of music that is not, or perhaps never has been, commercially available, (ie a family recording or suchlike) Wesley Music will be happy to process these items in their studio prior to downloading the track to us. Please note that items of this nature should be carefully packed and sent to Wesley Music, in plenty of time, via insured post or carrier or email. (please be aware that Wesley Music can take no responsibility for items not in their personal possession).
