

# Warriston Crematorium

## Music for Funeral Services

- Where a family wish a tape, CD or a particular piece of organ music to be played at a funeral service, the 'Request for Music' form should be completed and faxed to the crematorium as soon as possible and in any event at least 24 hours before the service.
- All tapes, CDs and sheet music (where this is being supplied by the family or funeral director) should be handed in to the Crematorium as soon as possible, and preferably 24 hours before the service. This will enable them to be checked by crematorium staff to ensure the service flows smoothly.
- We regret that it will not be possible to accept music at the time of the service. We would be grateful if you could ensure that families are made aware of this when the funeral is being arranged.
- All tapes and CDs should be clearly marked with the time and date of the service.
- If the family would like their own organist to play at the service, the Crematorium should be given 24 hours' notice.
- Not all music is suitable for adaptation for playing on the organ.
- Each piece of music must be on a separate blank tape. There should be no other recordings on the tape(s). However, a particular piece of music may be recorded a number of times consecutively on the same tape, if it is desired to lengthen the playing time for entry or exit
- We reserve the right to refuse to accept any CD, tape or piece of music if it is considered to be unsuitable or if the above instructions have not been followed
