A plastic spiked vase is provided for this purpose. This floral tribute and the plaque supplied by the Company are the only items which may be placed on or by the rose bush. Any other items will be removed by Crematorium staff.

If the rose bush needs, for whatever reason to, to be replaced, it will be replaced with as near a match as possible to the original rose. Replacements are normally carried out between the months of November and March.
