

# Warriston Crematorium

## Music for Funeral Services

- Where a family wish music from the Vivedia Music Engine system, the completed Request for Music form must be handed into Warriston or faxed to 0131 551 6753 with due regard to the required notice. Music that we hold on file requires 24 hours' notice. Music that has to be sourced requires 48 hours' notice. The crematorium can be contacted on 0131 552 3020 to check availability.
- Where a family wish a special CD or a particular piece of organ music to be played, the completed Request for Music form should be handed into Warriston or faxed to 0131 551 6753 as soon as possible and in any event at least 24 hours before the service.
- All CDs and sheet music (where this is being supplied by the family or funeral director) must be handed in to Warriston as soon as possible and in any event at least 24 hours before the service. This will allow the crematorium staff to carry out any necessary checks, to allow the service to flow smoothly.
- We regret that it is not possible to accept music at the time of the service, and we would be grateful if families were made aware of this when the funeral is being arranged.
- All CDs should be clearly marked with the time and date of the service.
- If the family would like to use their own organist, the crematorium should be given 24 hours notice.
- Not all music is suitable for adaptation for playing on the organ.
- We reserve the right to refuse to accept any CD or piece of music that we consider to be unsuitable, or if the above instructions have not been followed.
- We maintain all our equipment to a very high standard, including our audio and video equipment; however we cannot guarantee that they will never fail. In the unlikely event of a malfunction, we will endeavour to minimise any effect to our service provision.
